Introduction to the Text;

Isaiah 7:1-25

It was heartbreaking to see, no doubt even worse to experience, the death of a nation. The northern kingdom having already been compromised, and now Judah in the south is being prepared, by its own sin, its destruction.

The Lord was (is) faithful even in the face of the nation's sins and rejection of God, the Lord still sent His word out to the people. He still had his prophets speaking forth His word.

God's Word is a blessing "until" it is rejected.
Then, when time runs out - it becomes a "curse"

GOD'S WORD IS ALWAYS TRUE

1.) Because God keeps His Word

vs. 1-9

Isaiah 7:1-2

Now it came to pass in the days of Ahaz the son of Jotham, the son of Uzziah, king of Judah, that Re'zin king of Syria and Pe'kah the son of Remaliah, king of **Israel**, (*the northern kingdom*)

...that **Rezin** king of **Syria** and **Pekah** the son of Remaliah, king of **Israel**, went up to Jerusalem to make war against it, but could not prevail against it. 2 And it was told to the house of **David**, (*Judah, the southern kingdom*) saying, "**Syria's** forces are deployed in **Ephraim** (*Judah*) were moved (*shaken, reeling, sic*) as the trees of the woods are moved with the wind.

Isaiah 7:3-9

THEN THE LORD SAID to Isaiah, "Go out now to meet Ahaz, you (*Isaiah*) and Shear-Yashub (= a remnant shall return) your son, (*Isaiah's other son was named Mala-shall-a-haz-baz = a remnant shall escape*) at the end of the aqueduct from the upper pool, on the highway to the Fuller's Field, 4 and say to him: "**Take heed, and be quiet; do not fear or be fainthearted** for these two stubs of smoking firebrands, for the fierce anger of Rezin and Syria, and the son of Remaliah. 5 Because Syria, Ephraim, and the son of Remaliah have plotted evil against you, saying, 6 "Let us go up against Judah and trouble it, and let us make a gap in its wall for ourselves, and set a king over them, the son of Tabel" - - 7 thus says the Lord GOD: "It shall not stand, Nor shall it come to pass. 8 For the head of Syria is Damascus, And the head of Damascus is Rezin. Within sixty-five years Ephraim will be broken, So that it will not be a people. 9 The head of Ephraim is Samaria, And the head of Samaria is Remaliah's son. If you will not believe, Surely you shall not be established." ' ' "
