

Isaiah 42:1-25

“Behold! My Servant whom I uphold, My Elect One in whom My soul delights! I have put My Spirit upon Him; He will bring forth justice to the Gentiles.

fixed on Him. ...





Let the inhabitants of Sela sing, let them shout from the top of the mountains. **12** Let them give glory to the LORD, ...

Isaiah 42:10-13

... And declare His praise in the coastlands. **13** The LORD shall go forth like a mighty man; He shall stir up His zeal like a man of war. He shall cry out, yes, shout aloud; He shall prevail against His enemies.

... as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.

Now I will cry like a woman in labor, I will pant and gasp at once. **15** I will lay waste the mountains and hills, And dry up all their vegetation; I will make the rivers coastlands, and I will dry up the pools. **16** I will bring the blind by a way they did not know; I will lead them in paths they have not known. **20** seeing many things, but you do not observe; opening the ears, but he does not hear.”


Isaiah 42:18-20

The LORD is well pleased for His righteousness' sake; He will exalt the law and make it honorable.  
**22** But this is a people robbed and plundered; all of them are snared in holes, And they are hidden in prison houses; They are for prey, and no one delivers; for plunder, and no one says,  
“Restore!”

Isaiah 42:21-22

Who among you will give ear to this? Who will listen and hear for the time to come? **24** Who gave Jacob for plunder, and Israel to the robbers? Was it not the LORD, He against whom we have sinned? For they would not walk in His ways, Nor were they obedient to His law. **25** Therefore He has poured on him the fury of His anger and the strength of battle; It has set him on fire all around, ...

Isaiah 42:23-25



... Yet he did not know; And it burned him,  
Yet he did not take it to heart.
