Introduction to the Text;

Isaiah 6:1-13

If you remember back in Isaiah chapter 1,

we began the book of Isaiah by starting with Chapter 6 – why? Because the whole of the book and his ministry begins with his calling from God.

God called Isaiah out of his "local-world".

He does the same with all His people including you and me.

Romans 1:7

To all who are in Rome, beloved of God, called to be saints:

1 Corinthians 1:2

To the church of God which is at Corinth, to those who are sanctified in Christ Jesus, **called to be saints**, with all who in every place call on the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both theirs and ours:

Ephesians 1:1

Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, to the saints who are in Ephesus, and faithful in Christ Jesus:

Colossians 1:2

To the saints and faithful brethren in Christ who are in Colosse:

Philippians 1:1

Paul and Timothy, bondservants of Jesus Christ, To all the saints in Christ Jesus who are in Philippi,

This is **an emotional message** for me to bring. It was the first sermon I publicly preached at a Calvary Chapel 25 years ago.

But I'm not emotional because of that, that is not the reason – the reason is because my nation, my country has fallen so far in those short years and will soon be judged for the

wickedness that; "The Church and Her Pastor's have allowed

to happen to the Nation."

1.) It is designed by God Himself

vs. 1-4

Isaiah 6:1-4

In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, high and lifted up, and the train of His robe filled the temple. 2 Above it stood seraphim; each one had six wings: with two he covered his face, with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew. 3 And one cried to another and said: "Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts; The whole earth is full of His glory!" 4 And the posts of the door were shaken by the voice of him who cried out, and the house was filled with smoke.

Isaiah's calling appears to be connected

to the removing of King Uzziah. Not until the King is dead that Isaiah sees the real realm and power behind world affairs. (he was a very good, godly, effective king)

Think of the difference between a Ronald Reagan and a Barak Obama

First off – Is the Overwhelming Glory that Isaiah sees.

(like the book of revelation, Isaiah is let into the heavenly scene)

1 I saw the **Lord** (Adonai) sitting on a throne, high and lifted up, and the train (glory) of His robe filled the temple. 2 Above it stood **seraphim** (fiery or burning ones); each one had six wings: with two he covered his face, with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew. 3 And one **cried** to another (imagine the sound of it)

This is a scene in Heaven, from Heaven above.

This is no earthly temple or throne

The Bible tells us that there are Orders or Varying Type's of Angels.

Seraph-im = Burning ones at the throne / Cherub-im = around and beside the throne. /

Arch Angels seem to preside over heavenly and earthly events. - - and then there are The Four Living Creatures in Revelation.

So, when did God actually call Isaiah?

I saw the Lord (Adonai) sitting on a throne, high and lifted up

Jeremiah 1:4-5

Then the word of the LORD came to me, saying: 5 "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you; Before you were born I sanctified you; I ordained you a prophet to the nations."

When did God call you out from this world?

Ephesians 1:3-6

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ, 4 just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love, 5 having predestined us to adoption as sons by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, 6 to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He made us accepted in the Beloved.

The Apostle Paul's Calling

Galatians 1:13-16a

For you have heard of my former conduct in Judaism, how I persecuted the church of God beyond measure and tried to destroy it. 14 And I advanced in Judaism beyond many of my contemporaries in my own nation, being more exceedingly zealous for the traditions of my fathers. :15 But when it pleased God, who separated me from my mother's womb and called me through His grace, 16 to reveal His Son in me, that I might preach Him among the Gentiles,

vs. 5

Isaiah 6:5

So I said: "Woe is me, for I am undone! Because I am a man of unclean lips, And I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; For my eyes have seen the King, The LORD of hosts."

2 Corinthians 2:14

Now thanks be to God who always leads us in triumph in Christ, and through us diffuses the fragrance of His knowledge in every place. **15** For we are to God the fragrance of Christ among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing. **16** To the one we are the aroma of death leading to death, and to the other the aroma of life leading to life.
