**Isaiah 26:1-21**

#### Isaiah 26:1-6

In that day this song will be sung in the land of Judah: *“We have a strong city; God will appoint salvation for walls and bulwarks. 2 Open the gates, That the righteous nation which keeps the truth may enter in. 3 You will keep him in perfect peace, Whose mind is stayed on You, Because he trusts in You. 4 Trust in the LORD forever, For in YAH, the LORD, is everlasting strength. 5 For He brings down those who dwell on high, The lofty city; He lays it low, He lays it low to the ground, He brings it down to the dust. 6 The foot shall tread it down - - The feet of the poor And the steps of the needy.”*

#### Isaiah 26:7-11

7 The way of the just is **uprightness**; O Most Upright, You **weigh** the path of the just. 8 Yes, in the way of Your judgments, O LORD, we have waited for You; The **desire** of our soul is for Your **name** And for the **remembrance** of You. 9 With my **soul** I have desired You in the night, Yes, by my **spirit** within me I will seek You **early**; For when Your **judgments** are in the earth, The inhabitants of the world will learn **righteousness**. 10 Let **grace** be shown to the wicked, Yet he will not learn righteousness; In the land of uprightness he will deal unjustly, And will not behold the majesty of the LORD. 11 LORD, when Your hand is lifted up, they will not see. But they will see and be ashamed For their envy of people; Yes, the fire of Your enemies shall devour them.

#### Isaiah 26:12-18

12 LORD, You will establish peace for us, For You have also done all our works in us. 13 O LORD our God, masters besides You Have had dominion over us; But by You only we make mention of Your name. 14 They are dead, they will not live; They are deceased, they will not rise. Therefore You have punished and destroyed them, And made all their

memory to perish. 15 You have increased the nation, O LORD, You have increased the nation; You are glorified; You have expanded all the borders of the land. 16 LORD, in trouble they have visited You, They poured out a prayer when Your chastening was upon them. 17 As a woman with child is in pain and cries out in her pangs, When she draws near the time of her delivery, So have we been in Your sight, O LORD. 18 We have been with child, we have been in pain; We have, as it were, brought forth wind; We have not accomplished any deliverance in the earth, Nor have the inhabitants of the world fallen.

### **Isaiah 26:19-21**

Your dead shall live; Together with my dead body they shall arise. Awake and sing, you who dwell in dust; For your dew is like the dew of herbs, And the earth shall cast out the dead. 20 Come, my people, enter your chambers, And shut your doors behind you; Hide yourself, as it were, for a little moment, Until the indignation is past. 21 For behold, the LORD comes out of His place To punish the inhabitants of the earth for their iniquity; The earth will also disclose her blood, And will no more cover her slain.

## 2.) It will be those who are its citizens

*4 Trust in the LORD forever, For in YAH, the LORD, is everlasting strength . 5 For He brings down those who dwell on high, The lofty city; He lays it low, He lays it low to the ground, He brings it down to the dust. 6 The foot shall tread it down - - The feet of the poor And the steps of the needy.”*

### Isaiah 66:7-16

“Before she was in labor, she gave birth; Before her pain came, She delivered a male child. **8** Who has heard such a thing? Who has seen such things? Shall the earth be made to give birth in one day? Or shall a nation be born at once? For as soon as Zion was in labor, She gave birth to her children. **9** Shall I bring to the time of birth, and not cause delivery?” says the **LORD**. “Shall I who cause delivery shut up the womb?” says your God. **10** “Rejoice with Jerusalem, And be glad with her, all you who love her; Rejoice for joy with her, all you who mourn for her; **11** That you may feed and be satisfied With the consolation of her bosom, That you may drink deeply and be delighted With the abundance of her glory.” :**12** For thus says the **LORD**: “Behold, I will extend peace to her like a river, And the glory of the Gentiles like a flowing stream. Then you shall feed; On her sides shall you be carried, And be dandled on her knees. **13** As one whom his mother comforts, So I will comfort you; And you shall be comforted in Jerusalem.” **14** When you see this, your heart shall rejoice, And your bones

shall flourish like grass; The hand of the **LORD** shall be known to His servants, And His indignation to His enemies. **15** For behold, the **LORD** will come with fire And with His chariots, like a whirlwind, To render His anger with fury, And His rebuke with flames of fire. **16** For by fire and by His sword The **LORD** will judge all flesh; And the slain of the **LORD** shall be many.

#### Psalm 68:4

Sing to God, sing praises to His name; Extol Him who rides on the clouds, By His name **YAH**, And rejoice before Him.

#### Isaiah 12:2

Behold, God is my salvation, I will trust and not be afraid; "For **YAH**, the **LORD**, is my strength and song; He also has become my salvation.' "

### Verse 9a

## Verse 9b

With my **soul** I have desired You in the night, Yes,

#### Zechariah 14:16-20

And it shall come to pass that everyone who is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall go up from year to year to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, and to keep the Feast of Tabernacles. **17** And it shall be that whichever of the families of the earth do not come up to Jerusalem to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, on them there will be no rain. **18** If the family of Egypt will not come up and enter in, they shall have no rain; they shall receive the plague with which the LORD strikes the nations who do not come up to keep the Feast of Tabernacles. **19** This shall be the punishment of Egypt and the punishment of all the nations that do not come up to keep the Feast of Tabernacles. **:20** In that day "HOLINESS TO THE LORD" shall be engraved on the bells of the horses.

## Verse 10

**10** Let **grace** be shown to the wicked, Yet he will not learn righteousness; In the land of uprightness he will deal unjustly, And will not behold the majesty of the **LORD**.

## Verse 11

**LORD**, when Your hand is lifted up, they will not see. But they will see and be ashamed For their envy of people; Yes, the fire of Your enemies shall devour them.

**Proverbs 9:8-9**

Do not correct a scoffer, lest he hate you; Rebuke a wise man, and he will love you. **9** Give instruction to a wise man, and he will be still wiser; Teach a just man, and he will increase in learning.

**Titus 1:15-16**
