Introduction to the Text; **Isaiah 41:1-29**

*“I have found it interesting and telling that when the atheist is trying to describe something of grandeur, they almost always borrow from the Divine when trying to explain what it is that they see and feel.”*

The atheist claims that;

“Man created God in his own image”

but if that were true – then why would man create a God that is honest enough to tell mankind that he is in big trouble?

Perhaps more than any other doctrine of the Bible, there is none more discussed and argued about than the Doctrine of The Sovereignty of God

**By Sovereignty – The Bible Teaches That God is** Preeminent in Nature. He is **Omniscient** meaning that He is all knowing. He is **Omnipotent** meaning that all power belongs to Him.

He is **Omnipresent** meaning that there is no place where He cannot be.

## Psalm 139:1-18

O LORD, You have searched me and known me. 2 You know my sitting down and my rising up; You understand my thought afar off. 3 You comprehend my path and my lying down, And are acquainted with all my ways. 4 For there is not a word on my tongue, But behold, O LORD, You know it altogether. 5 You have hedged me behind and before, And laid Your hand upon me. 6 Such knowledge is too wonderful for me; It is high, I cannot attain it. 7 Where can I go from Your Spirit? Or where can I flee from Your presence? 8 If I ascend into heaven, You are there; If I make my bed in hell, behold, You are there. 9 If I take the wings of the morning, And dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea, 10 Even there Your hand shall lead me, And Your right hand shall hold me. 11 If I say, "Surely the darkness shall fall on me," Even the night shall be light about me; 12 Indeed, the darkness shall not hide from You, But the night shines as the day; The darkness and the light are both alike to You. 13 For You formed my inward parts; You covered me in my mother's womb. 14 I will praise You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; Marvelous are Your works, And that my soul knows very well. 15 My frame was not hidden from You, When I was made in secret, And skillfully wrought in the lowest parts of the earth (womb). 16 Your eyes saw my substance, being yet unformed. And in Your book they all were written, The days fashioned for me, When as yet there were none of them. 17 How precious also are Your thoughts to me, O God! How great is the sum of them! 18 If I should count them, they would be more in number than the sand; When I awake, I am still with You.

vs. 8-13

#### Verse 8-10

8 “But you, **Israel**, are My servant, **Jacob** whom I have **chosen**, The **descendants** of **Abraham** My friend. 9 You whom I have **taken** from the **ends of the earth**, And **called** from its farthest regions, And **said** to you, “You are My servant, I have chosen you and **have not cast you away**: 10 **Fear not, for I am with you; Be not dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, Yes, I will help you, I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.**’

#1.) **Fear not yaw-ray**’

to be gripped, squeezed, choked, to shutter because of emotional trauma, (the answer is) for I am with you;

#2.) **Be not dismayed shaw-aw**

to gaze or to stare at a situation until it overcomes you. to be reduced by it, (the answer is) for I am your God.

#3.) **I will strengthen you, aw-mats**’

confirm you, stand alongside you, encourage you, (the answer is) Yes, I will help you,

#4.) **I will uphold you taw-mak**’

hold you near. Keep close, hang on to (the answer is) with My righteous right hand.’

**Romans 11:11-12, 16-20**

I say then, have they stumbled that they should fall? Certainly not! But through their fall, to provoke them to jealousy, salvation has come to the Gentiles. 12 Now if their fall is riches for the world, and their failure riches for the Gentiles, how much more their fullness!... :16 For if the firstfruit is holy, the lump is also holy; and if the root is holy, so are the branches. 17 And if some of the branches were broken off, and you, being a wild olive tree, were grafted in among them, and with them became a partaker of the root and fatness of the olive tree, 18 do not boast against the branches. But if you do boast, remember that you do not support the root, but the root supports you. :19 You will say then, "Branches were broken off that I might be grafted in." 20 Well said. Because of unbelief they were broken off, and you stand by faith. Do not be haughty, but fear.

**Ephesians 2:11-13**

Therefore remember that you, once Gentiles in the flesh—who are called Uncircumcision by what is called the Circumcision made in the flesh by hands—  
12 that at that time you were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world. 13 But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.

vs. 14-20

14 “Fear not, you worm **Jacob**, You men of **Israel! I will help you,**” says the LORD And your Redeemer, the Holy One of **Israel**. 15 “Behold, I will make you into a new threshing sledge with sharp teeth; You shall thresh the mountains and beat them small, And make the hills like chaff. 16 You shall winnow them, the wind shall carry them away, And the whirlwind shall scatter them; You shall rejoice in the LORD, And glory in the **Holy One of Israel**. 17 “The poor and needy seek water, but there is none, Their tongues fail for thirst. I, the LORD, will hear them; I, **the God of Israel**, will not forsake them. 18 I will open rivers in desolate heights, And fountains in the midst of the valleys; I will make the wilderness a pool of water, And the dry land springs of water. 19 I will plant in the wilderness the cedar and the acacia tree, The myrtle and the oil tree; I will set in the desert the cypress tree and the pine and the box tree together, **20 That they may see and know, And consider and understand together, That the hand of the LORD has done this, And the Holy One of Israel has created it.**

### 5.) He Who exposes deception

vs. 21-29

**Here is God’s Challenge to all False Religions and Their False Prophets & False Teachers.**

## Verse 21-29

21 “Present your case,” says the LORD. “Bring forth your strong reasons,” says the King of Jacob. 22 “Let them bring forth and show us what will happen; Let them show the former things, what they were, That we may consider them, And know the latter end of them; Or declare to us things to come. 23 Show the things that are to come hereafter, That we may know that you are gods; Yes, do good or do evil, That we may be dismayed and see it together. 24 Indeed you are nothing, And your work is nothing; He who chooses you is an abomination.

25 “I have raised up one from the north (Cyrus/Jesus), And he shall come; From the rising of the sun he shall call on **My name**; And he (Cyrus/Jesus) shall come against princes as though mortar, As the potter treads clay. 26 **Who has declared from the beginning, that we may know? And former times, that we may say, “He is righteous?” Surely there is no one who shows, Surely there is no one who declares, Surely there is no one who hears your words.** 27 The first time I said to Zion, “Look, there they are!” And I will give to Jerusalem one who brings good tidings. 28 For I looked, and there was no man; I looked among them, but there was no counselor, Who, when I asked of them, could answer a word. 29 Indeed they are all worthless; Their works are nothing; Their molded images are wind and confusion.
