The Theme of His “Arriving” Is Now Isaiah’s Main Focus of Message To The End of The Book

**In the grand scheme of things,
There is a chronological order to the coming events,
hosted by God to this earth that are on His calendar.**

Regarding the Church:

the next recorded, biblical event to happen is the rapture of the church age believers / the bride of Christ is caught away.

Regarding the Israel:

the next recorded, biblical event is Israel’s re-gathering to the land followed by a an unusual, but great war.

Regarding the World:

the next recorded biblical event, is a scale of global deception & ecological destruction never before seen.

Arriving – The Second Coming of Jesus Christ

1.) The preparation of His nation

vs. 1-3

Isaiah 64:1-3

Oh, that You would **rend the heavens!**

That You would **come down!** That the mountains might **shake at Your presence** - - 2 As fire **burns** brushwood, As fire causes water to **boil** - - To make Your name **known to Your adversaries**, That the nations may **tremble** at Your presence! :3 When *(or like when)* **You did awesome** things for which we did not look, **You came down**, The mountains shook at Your presence.

“It was of Biblical Proportions...”

is the term used to describe unusual events or natural disasters.

2.) The penitence of His elect

vs. 4-7

Isaiah 64:4-7

For since the beginning of the world men have not heard nor perceived by the ear, nor has the eye seen any God besides You, Who **acts** for the one **who waits for Him....**

The way the un-kept mind operates apart from God.

Verse 4a

For **since the beginning** of the world men **have not** heard nor perceived

1 Corinthians 2:9-10

But as it is written: “Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, nor have entered into the heart of man the things which God has prepared for those who love Him.” 10 But God has revealed them to us through His Spirit. For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God.

Romans 8:6-8

For to be carnally minded is death, but to be spiritually minded is life and peace. 7 Because the carnal mind is enmity against God; for it is not subject to the law of God, nor indeed can be. 8 So then, those who are in the flesh cannot please God.

1 Corinthians 2:12-15

Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might know the things that have been freely given to us by God. :13 These things we also speak, not in words which man’s wisdom teaches but which the Holy Spirit teaches, comparing spiritual things with spiritual. 14 But the natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; nor can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned. 15 But he who is spiritual judges all things, yet he himself is rightly judged by no one.

Romans 1:18-22

For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness, 19 because what may be known of God is manifest in them, for God has shown it to them. 20 For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse, 21 because, although they knew God, they did not glorify Him as God, nor were thankful, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened.
22 Professing to be wise, they became fools,

The way the kept or renewed mind operates in God.

Verse 4b-5a

Who **acts** for the one **who waits for Him....**

acts heb: **a'sah** – to involve one's self. To be engaged. To stand up and act on the behalf of another. (nag.) to not sit idle or removed. To be intimately involved. (not a spectator)

waits heb: **cha'kah** – to wait with anticipation. to sit with longing and expectancy.

{Just How Awesome God is to Those Who Wait}

You can never “out wait God” – But ...

Verse 5a

...5 You meet him who **rejoices** and **does righteousness**,
Who **remembers** You in Your ways.

Verse 5b-

You are indeed angry, for we have sinned - - In these ways we continue; and **we need to be saved**. 6 But we are all like **an unclean thing**, And all our righteousnesses are **like filthy rags**; We all fade as a leaf, and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away. 7 And there is no one who calls on Your name, Who stirs himself up to take hold of You; For You have hidden Your face from us, and have consumed us because of our iniquities.

Proverbs 28:13-14

He who covers his sins will not prosper,
But whoever confesses and forsakes them will have mercy. 14 Happy is the man who is always reverent, but he who hardens his heart will fall into calamity.

Numbers 32:23

But if you do not do so (obey), then take note, you have sinned against the Lord; and be sure of this - your sin will find you **out**.
(spring up and out. Issue forth. grow up and out)

James 1:12-15

Blessed is the man who endures temptation; for when he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him. **13** Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am tempted by God"; for God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does He Himself tempt anyone. **14** But each one is tempted **when** he is drawn away (1) **by his own desires** and (2) enticed. **15** Then, when desire has (3) conceived, it (4) gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, (5) brings forth death. :**16** Do not be deceived, my beloved brethren.

So How Can You Know

3.) The perception of His people

vs. 8-12

Isaiah 64:8-12

8 But now, O Lord, You are our Father;
We are the clay, and You our potter; and all we are the work of Your hand.

Because of our Messiah being The Lord Jesus Christ;

These are the **redemptive truths** that are ours as well.

Galatians 3:26-29

For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. 27 For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ. 28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus. 29 And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.

Verse 9a-12

9 Do not be furious, O Lord, **nor remember** iniquity forever;
***Only God has the Ability to Forget Sin,
Once it is Repented of.***

Verse 9b-12

Indeed, please look - - we (*the believing remnant of Israel*) all are Your people! 10 Your holy cities are a wilderness, Zion is a wilderness, Jerusalem a desolation. 11 Our holy and beautiful temple, Where our fathers praised You, Is burned up with fire; and all our pleasant things are laid waste. 12 Will You restrain Yourself because of these things, O Lord? Will You hold Your peace, and afflict us very severely?
